What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device when you visit a website. They help the website recognise your device and store information about your preferences or past actions.

Types of Cookies We Use

1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

- Essential for website functionality.
- Examples: User authentication, session management.

2. Performance Cookies

- Collect information about how visitors use our website.
- Help us improve user experience and measure site performance.

3. Functionality Cookies

- Enable the website to remember your preferences.
- Examples: Language settings, region-specific preferences.

4. Targeting/Advertising Cookies

- Track your browsing habits to deliver personalised advertisements.
- May be set by third-party advertising networks.

5. Anonymous Analytics Cookies

- Generated by web analytics tools such as Google Analytics.
- Used to understand how visitors interact with our website and to identify popular content.
- These cookies are completely anonymous and cannot identify individual users.

Third-Party Cookies

We may allow third-party providers, such as Google Analytics or social media platforms, to set cookies on our website. For example:

- **Analytics Cookies:** Used to track visitor statistics.
- **Social Media Cookies:** For sharing website content on platforms like Facebook or Twitter.

These third-party cookies are governed by their respective providers' privacy policies.

How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to:

- Recognise and count website visitors.
- Understand how visitors interact with our website.
- Improve website functionality and security.
- Deliver targeted marketing campaigns.

How to Manage Cookies

You can manage or disable cookies through your browser settings. Here are some options:
